

# Sweepstakes Rules

1. **TIMING:** This incentive promotion includes 2020 United Way of Door County donations made through 5:00pm Central Time on Monday, December 14, 2020. Participants must be legal residents of Wisconsin, and at least 18 years of age to be eligible for the prize.
2. **PRIZES:** Winners will receive one of three cash prizes: one cash prize of \$500, and two cash prizes of \$250. The cash prize is donated to United Way of Door County by: Jim Olson Motors. Odds of winning depend on number of eligible entries received. One prize per person.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Any United Way of Door County donor that makes an unrestricted gift of \$52 (or \$1 per week) prior to December 14, 2020 (exclusive of any employer match) through their employer will be automatically entered into the Cash Prize Sweepstakes for one chance to win. Entry without donation for the Cash Prize Sweepstakes can be made by sending one entry on 4"x6" cards to United Way of Door County, ATTN: 2020 Cash Prize Sweepstakes, PO Box 223, Sturgeon Bay, WI 54235, containing name, address, phone number, and email address. A limit of ONE (1) entry per person, automatic or otherwise, allowed for the Cash Prize Sweepstakes. Employees of United Way of Door County and their immediate families are not eligible to participate. Only individuals are eligible for the 2020 Cash Prize Sweepstakes; organizations are not eligible. Online entries will not be accepted. An individual can only win one prize.
4. **ENTRIES:** The Pledge Form or Entry Card must be received by United Way of Door County by 5:00 p.m. Central Time on Monday, December 14, 2020. United Way of Door County will not be responsible for companies that fail to submit their employees' pledge forms or any other lost submissions by this date.
5. **DRAWING & ANNOUNCEMENT:** The potential winners of the sweepstakes will be drawn (randomly) from all valid entries on December 18, 2020 at the United Way of Door County's office. The potential winners will be required to provide proper photo identification and verification of compliance with these Official Rules prior to award of the prize. If the potential winner does not meet these eligibility requirements or is not in compliance with these Official Rules, the potential winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. The name of the prize winners will be publicly announced at on or around January 7, 2021.
6. **RELEASE:** By entering, all participants hereby agree to comply with these Official Rules, represent that he/she is eligible, consent to the use of his/her name and/or photograph for publicity purposes without further compensation, unless prohibited by law. All entrants release United Way of Door County, the donor listed in #2, and their employees, directors, officers and agents, parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, advertising, fulfillment, publicity and promotion agencies from any and all

claims or liability in connection with their participation in this promotion. Entrants agree to hold harmless United Way of Door County, the donor listed in #2, and their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, agencies, officers, directors and employees from responsibility for damages, losses or injuries, including death, personal injury or property damage, due in whole or part, directly or indirectly, from participation in this promotion or acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prize.

7. RECEIPT OF PRIZES: The prize may not be substituted for any other prize except by United Way of Door County due to unavailability. United Way of Door County reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify this promotion if not capable of completion as planned.

8. RESPONSIBILITY: Winners will be required to pay any applicable taxes and costs relating to the transactions, including, but not limited to, federal and state income taxes. Participation in this promotion may affect the tax deductibility of your undesignated gift. You should consult your tax advisor for more detailed information.

10. ENTRY INTEGRITY: Those individuals that qualify for the Cash Prize Drawing are automatically and systematically (not manually) entered into the drawing as their pledges are processed. Participating public sector campaigns do provide individual donor information, which is audited, so public sector qualifiers can be assured they will be included and there is little room for human error. Companies, who do not typically provide individual pledge information, may submit a list of those employees who have qualified. Those names are added to the database of automatic qualifiers. Additionally, those people who submitted an entry outside of the automatic qualification process are also entered into the database. Although we cannot publish the list of all those who qualify, if a workplace campaign requests a list of qualifiers from their own company, United Way of Door County can provide it prior to the drawing, but after all pledges received by December 14, 2020 have been posted.
