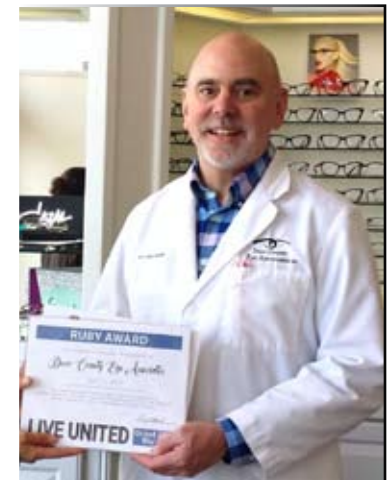
Our most important resource is you.
