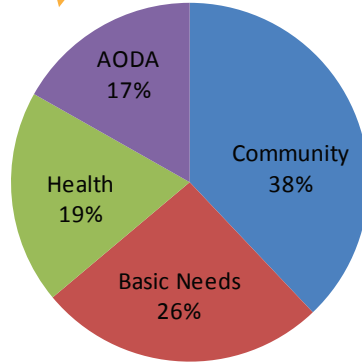

- Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse

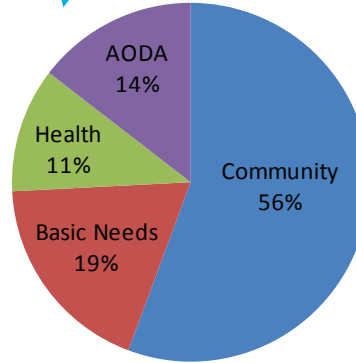

- \$110,273 dollars saved on prescriptions using the Family Wise card

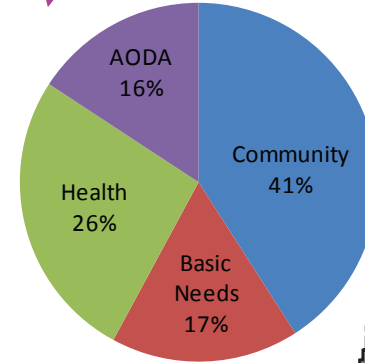
Baileys Harbor
Help Given 262 Times



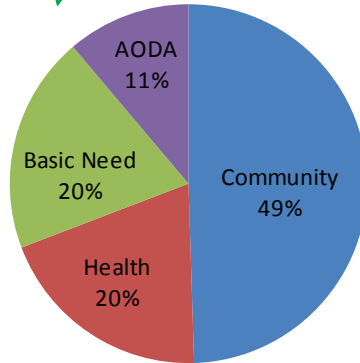
Ephraim
Help Given 83 Times



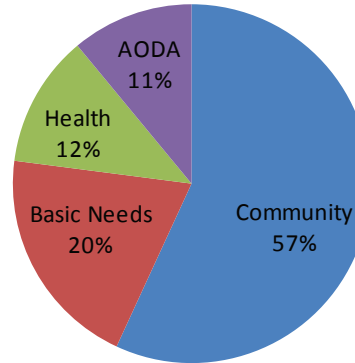
Fish Creek
Help Given 979 Times



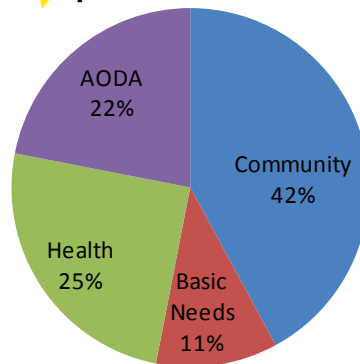
Egg Harbor
Help Given 542 Times



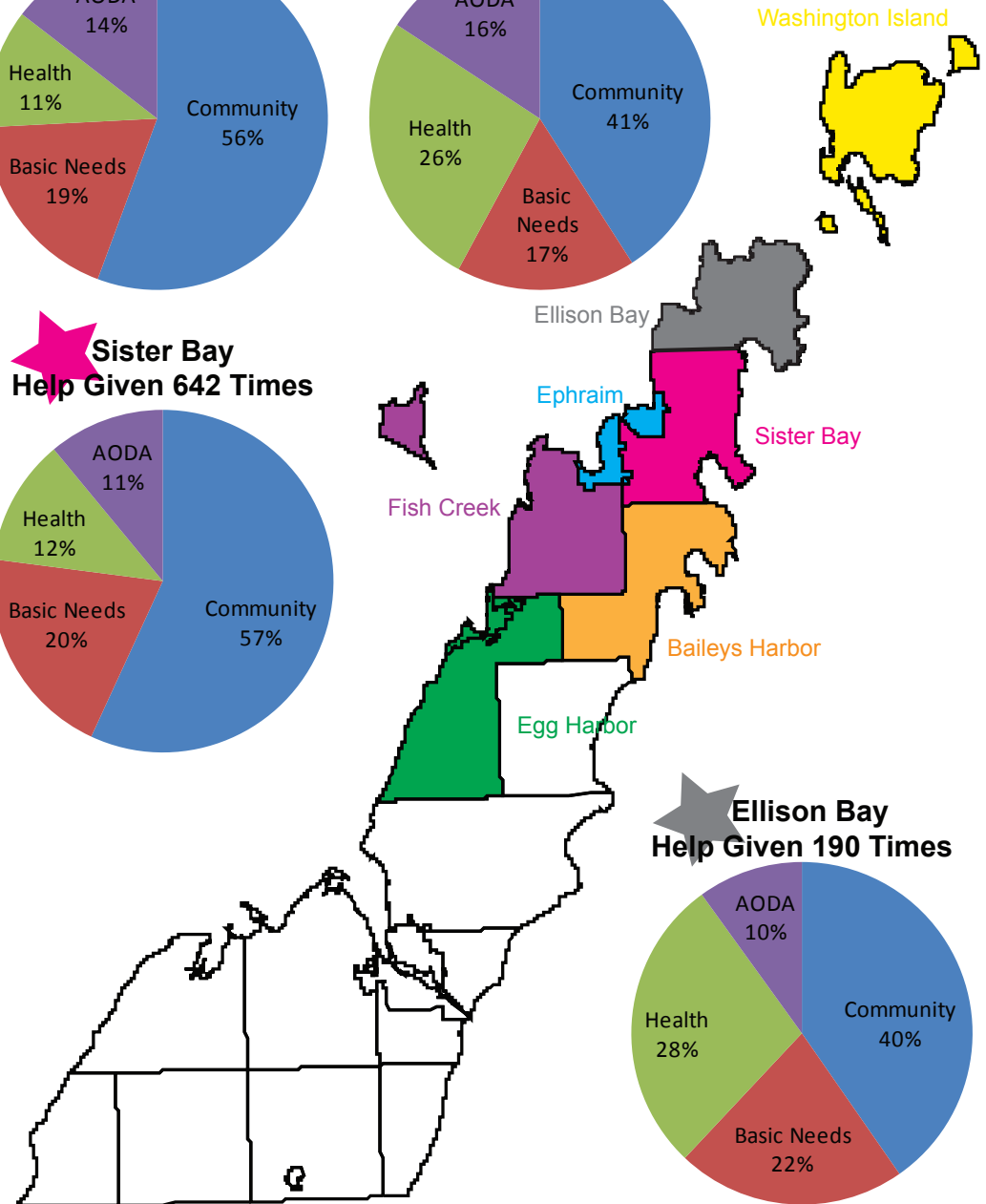
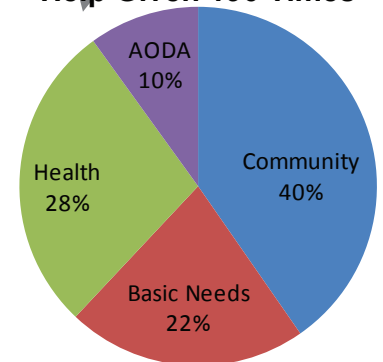
